

All of these journals are making changes on a continuing basis.

Electronic publishing, and the many advantages associated with electronic publishing, must be considered, including linking with appropriate consents and precautions to other articles, color photos at no extra cost, and streaming video. Peer review must become even much more inclusive and open, allowing a significantly greater proportion of experts to weigh in on new findings prior to publication.

Over the forthcoming months, readers will see changes in both appearance and content. Please note that not all of these changes will occur at one time.

I am confident that we, together, will achieve our goal of making *International Surgery* one of the best surgical journals in the world. I ask for your support and for your ongoing suggestions as we proceed.
